

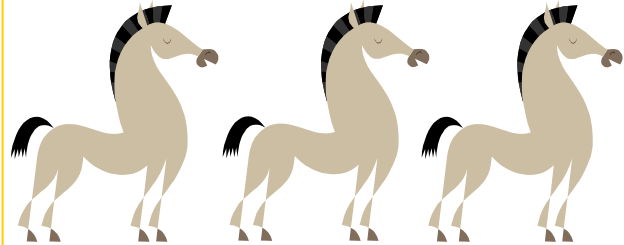
Kardella South Pony Club

Free Arena Use for Pony Club Members

Please note that only financial pony club members are able to use the arena at Kardella Palms ON THEIR CURRENT GRADED PONY CLUB MOUNT only.

ALL Members wishing to use the arena must inform Andrea by phone that they are coming!

All parents, friends etc. are to pay the normal arena hire fee (\$10.00 per hour per rider/horse or part thereof) or purchase one of our yearly arena passes (works out to about \$3.00 per week). Any other person must first sign a risk waiver form. This includes friends riding your horse!

A \$10.00 fee will apply if manure is not collected and the arena/parking area is not left clean. Please remove your cans/ drink bottles and other rubbish. This is NOT BEING DONE.

Pls note also that NO DOGS ARE ALLOWED

Chambons, draw reins, side reins and other illegal and dangerous artificial aids ARE NOT PERMITTED at either pony club or when hiring the arena and riders horses/riders are not covered by insurance if these artificial aids are used—EFA / FEI rules

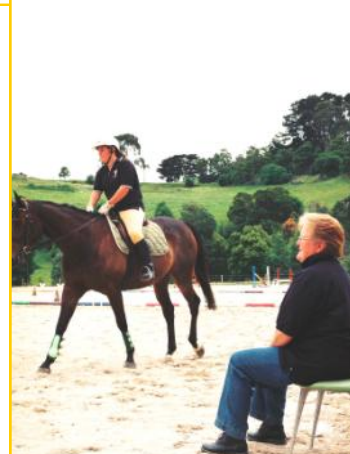
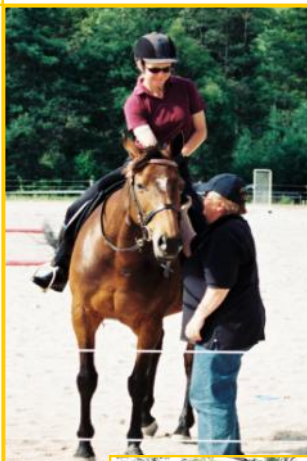
